- 1.) Jean Vanderville, is designated Chief Administrative Officer, and Tanya Hoar, Finance Director, is designated as Fiscal Officer.
- 2.) The Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to transfer up to 25% of a line-item amount approved in the General Appropriations Act to another line-time without prior approval, but subject to approval of the Board of County Road Commissioners at their next regular Board Meeting.
- 3.) The expenditure amount approved in the General Appropriations Act for Distributive Expense shall be allocated to the various other expenditure line-items in the proportion as the allocation of actual Distributive Expenses at year-end.
